

CONFESS THE WORD

Deuteronomy 28:1-14 – If I diligently obey the voice of the Lord, to observe all His commandments, and walk His ways: I will be blessed going in and going out. The Lord will cause my enemies to be defeated before my face; they shall come against me one way and flee before me 7 ways. The Lord will command the blessing on me in my storehouses and in all that I do, and He will bless me in the land He has given me. All the people of the earth shall see that I am called by the name of the Lord and they shall be afraid of me. The Lord will grant me plenty of goods. The Lord will open to me His heaven and bless all the work of my hands. He will make me the head and not the tail.

Job 36:11 – If I obey and serve Him, I shall spend all my days in prosperity and my years in pleasures.

Psalms 29:11 – The Lord will give strength and peace to me.

Psalms 84:11 – The Lord will withhold no good thing from me

Psalms 91 -- As I dwell in the secret place of the Most High, I will dwell in His shadow. He will deliver me from snares, pestilence, terror, arrows and destruction. Also, evil will not befall me nor any plaques come near my dwelling. He will give His angels charge over me and keep me in all my ways. I will trample the lion and the cobra. He will deliver me and answer me when I call to Him.

Psalms 103:3-5 – The Lord forgives all my iniquities, heals all my diseases, redeems my life from destruction, crowns me with loving-kindness and tender mercies, satisfies my mouth with good things, so that my youthfulness is renewed like the eagle's.

Proverbs 13:22 -- The wealth of the sinner is stored up for me, the righteous.

Proverbs 18:21 -- Death and life are in the power of my tongue.

Isaiah 40:31 – As I wait on the Lord, I shall renew my strength; I shall mount up with wings like eagles, I shall run and not be weary, I shall walk and not faint.

Isaiah 41:10 – I will fear not, for the Lord is with me. I will not be dismayed, for Jesus is my God. He will strengthen me and uphold me with His righteous right hand.

Isaiah 44:3 – The Lord will pour His Spirit and His blessing on my children.

Isaiah 53:4-12 -- Jesus has borne my grief and carried my sorrows. He was wounded for my transgressions, He was bruised for my iniquities; the chastisement for my peace was upon Him, and by His stripes I am healed. The Lord has laid on Him the iniquity of mine.

Isaiah 54:17 – No weapon formed against me shall prosper.

Isaiah 58:8 – As I fast, my healing shall spring forth speedily, and the glory of the Lord will be my rear guard.

Isaiah 58:10-11 – If I extend my soul to the hungry and satisfy the afflicted soul, then the Lord will guide me continually, satisfy my soul in drought, and strengthen my bones.

Jeremiah 15:21 – The Lord will deliver me from the hand of the wicked, and redeem me from the grip of the terrible.

Jeremiah 31:14 – The Lord will satiate my soul with abundance, and I will be satisfied with His goodness.

Malachi 3:10-12 – As I bring all my tithes into the storehouse, the Lord will open the windows of heaven and pour out for me such a blessing that there will not be room enough to receive it. He will rebuke the devourer for my sake, so that he will not destroy the fruit of my ground.

Matthew 6:33 – I seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all my necessities shall be added to me.

Matthew 7:7 – I ask, and it will be given to me; I seek, and I will find; I knock and it will be opened to me.

Matthew 11:12 --... I take the kingdom of heaven by force.

Matthew 11:28,30 – I go to the Lord, and He will give me rest. His yoke is easy and His burdens are light.

Matthew 13:11 – It has been given to me to know the mysteries of heaven.

Matthew 16:18 – As part of the church, the gates of Hades shall not prevail against me. I have the keys of the kingdom of heaven, and whatever I bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever I loose on earth will be loosed in heaven.

Matthew 17:20 -- ...if I have faith.... Nothing will be impossible to me.

Matthew 18:19-20 – if I touch and agree with another believer on earth concerning anything that we ask, it will be done for us by my Father in heaven. Where two or more are gathered together in His name, He is there in the midst of us.

Matthew 19:26 -- ...with God all things are possible

Matthew 21:22 – whatever things I ask in prayer, believing, I will receive.

Mark 16:17 – These signs will follow me because I believe in Jesus: in His name I will cast out demons; I will speak with new tongues; I will take up serpents; if I drink anything deadly, it will by no means hurt me; I will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover.

Luke 10:19 - I have the authority to trample on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall by any means hurt me. I rejoice because my name is written in heaven.

Luke 11:13 - If I know how to give good gifts to my children, how much more will my heavenly Father give me the Holy Spirit.

Luke 12:32 – I do not fear, for it is my Father's good pleasure to give me the kingdom.

Luke 14:11 – If I exalt myself, I will be humbled, and if I humble myself, I will be exalted.

John 1:12-13 – I have received Him and He has given me the right to become a child of God, to us who believe in His name: who were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God.

John 10:10 – Jesus came that I may have life, and that I may have it more abundantly.

John 12:26 – If I serve Him, I will follow Him; and where He is, there I will be also. If I serve Him, The Father will honor me.

John 14:14 – If I ask anything in His name, He will do it.

John 14:21 – I have His commandments and keep them, it is I who love Him. The Father will love those who love Him, and Jesus will love me and manifest Himself to me.

John 14:23 – If I love Him, I will keep His word; and The Father will love me, and They will come to me and make their home with me.

John 15:7 – If I abide in Him, and His words abide in me, I will ask what I desire, and it shall be done for me. The Father is glorified if I bear much fruit. As the Father loved Jesus, Jesus also has loved me; I abide in His love. If I keep His commandments, I will abide in His love. If I do these things His joy remains in me, and that my joy may be full.

John 16:15 – Jesus will take all the things the Father has and declare it to me.

John 16:24 – If I ask anything in His name, I will receive, that my joy may be full.

Romans 1:16 – I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ, for it is the power of God to salvation for everyone who believes.

Romans 4:17 – Through the power of God I can give life to the dead and call those things which do not exist as though they did

Romans 5:1-5 – I have been justified by faith, so I have peace with God through my Lord Jesus Christ, through whom I also have access by faith into this grace in which I stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God. Not only that, but I also glory in tribulations, knowing that tribulation produces perseverance; and perseverance, character; and character, hope. The Holy Spirit who was given to me has poured out the love of God in my heart.

Romans 5:11 – I rejoice in God through my Lord Jesus Christ, through whom I have now received reconciliation.

Romans 6:4-11 – I was buried with Jesus through baptism into death, that just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so I also should walk in newness of life. For if I have been united together in the likeness of His death, certainly I also shall be in the likeness of His resurrection. Knowing this, that my old man was crucified with Him, that the body of sin might be done away with, that I should no longer be a slave of sin. For he who has died has been freed from sin. Now if I died with Christ, I believe that I shall also live with Him, knowing that Christ, having been raised from the dead, dies no more. Death no longer has dominion over Him. For in the death that He died, He died to sin once for all; but the life that He lives, He lives to God. I consider myself to be dead indeed to sin, but alive to God in Christ Jesus my Lord.

Romans 8:1-2 -- There is therefore now no condemnation to me because I am in Christ Jesus. I do not walk according to the flesh, but according to the Spirit. The law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has made me free from the law of sin and death.

Romans 8:11 -- The Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in me, He who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to my mortal bodies through His Spirit who dwells in me.

Romans 8:15 – I did not receive the spirit of bondage again to fear, but I received the Spirit of adoption by whom I cry out, "Abba, Father."

Romans 8:28 – I know that all things work together for my good because I love God, and I am called according to His purpose.

Romans 8:37-39 – I am more than a conqueror through Him who loved me. I am persuaded that neither death nor life, nor angels nor principalities nor powers, nor things present nor things to come, nor height nor depth, nor any other created thing, shall be able to separate me from the love of God which is in Christ Jesus my Lord.

1 Corinthians 2:16 – I have the mind of Christ.

1 Corinthians 3:16 – I am the temple of God and that the Spirit of God dwells in me.

1 Corinthians 6:11 -- I was washed, sanctified, justified in the name of the Lord Jesus and by the Spirit of my God.

1 Corinthians 6:15 – I know that my body is a member of Christ. Shall I then take the members of Christ and make them members of a harlot? Certainly not!

1 Corinthians 6:17-20 – I am joined to the Lord and I am one spirit with Him. I flee sexual immorality. Every sin that I do is outside the body, but if I commit sexual immorality sins, I sin against my own body. My body is the temple of the Holy Spirit who is in me, whom I have from God, and I am not my own. I was bought at a price; therefore I glorify God in my body and in my spirit, which are God's.

1 Corinthians 10:13 -- No temptation has overtaken me except such as is common to man; but God is faithful, who will not allow me to be tempted beyond what I am able.

2 Corinthians 5:7 – I walk by faith and not by sight.

2 Corinthians 5:20-21 – I am an ambassador for Christ, as though God were pleading through us: I implore others on Christ's behalf, to be reconciled to God. He made Him who knew no sin to be sin for me, that I might become the righteousness of God in Him.

2 Corinthians 6:1-2 – As a worker together with Him I plead with unbelievers not to receive the grace of God in vain. He says: "In an acceptable time I have heard you, and in the day of salvation I have helped you." Behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation.

2 Corinthians 8:9 – I know the grace of my Lord Jesus Christ, that though He was rich, yet for my sake He became poor, that I through His poverty might become rich.

Galatians 2:20 – I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ who lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me.

Galatians 3:13-14 -- Christ has redeemed me from the curse of the law, having become a curse for me, that the blessing of Abraham might come upon me in Christ Jesus, that I might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith.

Galatians 3:26 – I am a son of God through my faith in Christ Jesus.

Ephesians 1:3-14 – God has blessed me with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places in Christ, just as He chose me in Him before the foundation of the world, that I should be holy and without blame before Him in love, having predestined me to adoption as a son by Jesus Christ to Himself, according to the good pleasure of His will, to the praise of the glory of His grace, by which He has made me accepted in the Beloved. In Him I have redemption through His blood; the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of His grace, which He made to abound toward me in all wisdom and prudence, having made known to me the mystery of His will. In Him also I have obtained an inheritance, being predestined according to the purpose of Him who works all things according to the counsel of His will, that I who trusted in Christ should be to the praise of His glory. In Him I have trusted, after I heard the word of truth, the gospel of my salvation; in whom also, having believed, I was sealed with the Holy Spirit of promise, who is the guarantee of my inheritance until the redemption of the purchased possession.

Ephesians 2:8 – By grace I have been saved through faith, and that faith being a gift from God.

Ephesians 3:20 – The Lord is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that I ask or think.

Philippians 1:6 – The Lord has begun a good work in me and will complete it until the day of Christ.

Philippians 4:7 – The peace of God will guard my heart and mind through Christ Jesus.

Philippians 4:19 – My God shall supply all my needs according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus.

Colossians 1:13 – I have been delivered from the power of darkness and been conveyed into the kingdom of the Son.

Colossians 2:9-15 – I am complete in Him, who is the head of all principality and power. In Him I putting off the body of the sins of the flesh, buried with Him in baptism, in which I also was raised with Him through faith in the working of God, who raised Him from the dead. I, being dead in my trespasses, He has made alive together with Him, having forgiven all my trespasses. And He has taken it out of the way, having nailed it to the cross. Having disarmed principalities and powers, He made a public spectacle of them, triumphing over them in it.

Hebrews 4:14-16 – I have a great High Priest who has passed through the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let me hold fast to my confession. For I do not have a High Priest who cannot sympathize with my weaknesses, but was in all points tempted as I am, yet without sin. I can therefore come boldly to the throne of grace, that I may obtain mercy and find grace to help in time of need.

James 4:7 – As I submit to God and resist the devil, he will flee from me.

2 Peter 1:2-4 – The Lord's divine power has given to me all things that pertain to life and godliness, through the knowledge of Him who called me. I have been given exceedingly great and precious promises, through these I may be a partaker in the divine nature.

1 John 4:4 – Greater is He that is in me than he who is in the world.

1 John 5:18 – I am born of God and the wicked one touches me not.
