

Jeremiah 30:17 For I will restore health to you And heal you of your wounds,' says the LORD

Isaiah 58: 11 The LORD will guide you continually, And satisfy your soul in drought, And strengthen your bones; You shall be like a watered garden, And like a spring of water, whose waters do not fail.

Deuteronomy 7: 12-15 "Then it shall come to pass, because you listen to these judgments, and keep and do them, that the LORD your God will keep with you the covenant and the mercy which He swore to your fathers. And He will love you and bless you and multiply you; He will also bless the fruit of your womb and the fruit of your land, your grain and your new wine and your oil, the increase of your cattle and the offspring of your flock, in the land of which He swore to your fathers to give you. You shall be blessed above all peoples; there shall not be a male or female barren among you or among your livestock. And the LORD will take away from you all sickness, and will afflict you with none of the terrible diseases of Egypt which you have known, but will lay them on all those who hate you.

Jeremiah 33: 6 Behold, I will bring it health and healing; I will heal them and reveal to them the abundance of peace and truth.

Then your light will break forth like the dawn, and your healing will quickly appear. (Isaiah 58:8 NIV)

Because thou hast made the LORD, which is my refuge, even the most High, thy habitation; there shall no evil befall thee, neither shall any plague come nigh thy dwelling. (Psalm 91:9-10 KJV)

Dear friend, I pray that you may enjoy good health and that all may go well with you, even as your soul is getting along well. (3 John 2 NIV)

I am the LORD, who heals you. (Exodus 15:26 NIV)

He sent his word, and healed them. (Psalm 107:20 KJV)

For you who fear my name, the Sun of Righteousness will rise with healing in his wings. (Malachi 4:2 TLB)

He himself bore our sins in his body on the tree, so that we might die to sins and live for righteousness; by his wounds you have been healed. (1 Peter 2:24)

Heal me, O LORD, and I shall be healed; save me, and I shall be saved: for thou art my praise. (Jeremiah 17:14)

Praise the LORD, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits who forgives all your sins and heals all your diseases. (Psalm 103:2-3 NIV)

Though I am surrounded by troubles, you will bring me safely through them. You will clench your fist against my angry enemies! Your power will save me. (Psalm 138:7 TLB)

We live within the shadow of the Almighty, sheltered by the God who is above all gods. This I declare, that he alone is my refuge, my place of safety; he is my God, and I am trusting him. (Psalm 91:1-2 TLB)
